

House Bill 1119 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To abolish the office of elected county surveyor of Chatham County; to provide that the
2 person currently serving as elected county surveyor shall serve the remainder of his or her
3 term; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws;
4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Pursuant to the authority granted by Code Section 36-7-2.1 of the O.C.G.A., the office of
8 elected county surveyor of Chatham County is abolished. The person serving as elected
9 county surveyor of Chatham County on January 1, 2016, shall continue to serve as such until
10 the expiration of the current term to which such person was elected.

11 **SECTION 2.**

12 This Act shall become law upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
13 without such approval.

14 **SECTION 3.**

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
