WHEREAS: The Georgia Master Gardener Volunteer Program is an educational program offered through county offices of the Georgia Cooperative Extension Service. Through this program, individuals are trained and certified in horticulture and related areas; and

WHEREAS: The Master Gardener Program is designed to develop highly-skilled volunteers who will commit to a minimum of 50 hours of service in exchange for 40 hours of horticultural training. Through the Master Gardener program, thousands of people in the United States have been trained as volunteers; and

WHEREAS: These individuals, in turn, volunteer their expertise and services under the direction of their County Extension Agent to help others through horticultural projects that benefit the community; and

WHEREAS: Master Gardeners bring the latest horticultural information and practices from the world of research to their communities' landscapes and gardens; and

WHEREAS: Master Gardeners have helped Georgians improve their quality of life and the environment. We are thankful for all that they do for our state; now

THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 16, 2013, as MASTER GARDENER DAY in Georgia.
